American Polyfilm, Inc. (APi) supplies Top Dog Mfg. polyether polyurethane film that is composed of resin that "When used unmodified for the manufacture of food contact articles... will comply with the U.S. Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and Food Additive Regulation 21 CFR 177.2600".

In processing this resin into film, we use ingredients that are considered by the FDA to be G.R.A.S. (Generally Recognized As Safe) under FDA 21 CFR 182.90. Those ingredients are sanctioned for food contact applications under 21 CFR 175.300.

No chemical reactions take place during processing of the polyurethane resin into polyurethane film.
